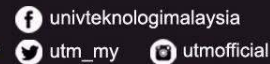

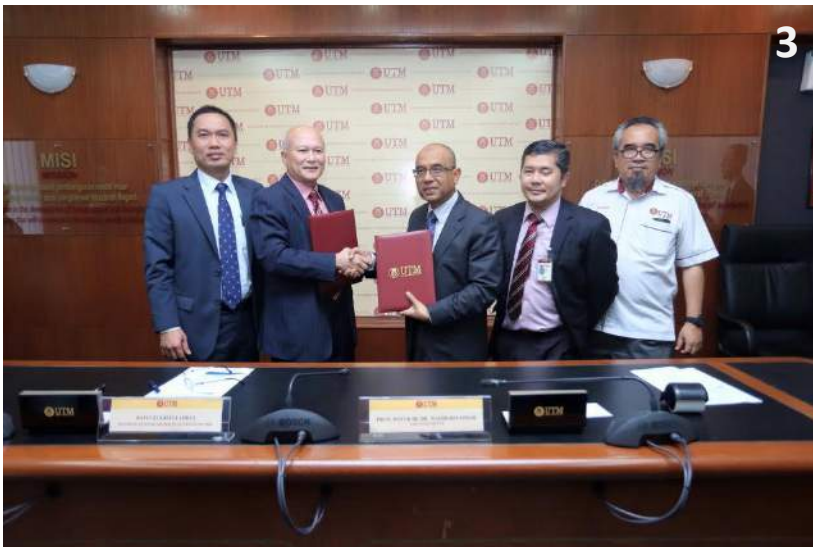

UTM's Cambodian game changer

SENSE OF PURPOSE: Help comes in many forms, and some leave more permanent effects than others

MALAYSIANS are fond of helping others. Whether in the country or overseas. This is how it has been for years. The perception among some is that Malaysia is so rich, so advanced, so modern, so successful.

However, Dr Mohd. Hisham Baidi, a senior lecturer in the Landscape Architecture Department, Built Environment Faculty of Civil and Environmental Engineering, UTM, said that a different method is more useful in the long run, providing a more sustainable approach to helping others, one that endorses the true sense of time and offering benefits in the philosophy that has been passed on to a village in Cambodia, where it is regarded to be the best practice.

Dr Hisham, with a team comprising his colleagues and undergraduates, is confident that this approach will help a small village transform into a tourism site and a sustainable community.

PEMBANGUNAN LESTARI KOMUNITI ASEAN Pusat komersial RM300,000 di Kemboja

Kuala Lumpur: Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM) dan pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) membangunkan sebuah pusat komersial bernilai RM300,000 di Kampung Khlong Sbek di Kemboja yang ditubuhkan sejak 2012, menerusi projek Pembangunan Lestari Komuniti ASEAN.

Sejak kemunculan itu yang diilhamkan projek, pejabat kenderaan, pusat jabatan, kedai serbaneka dan pusat siber dijanjikan siap pertengahan tahun 2016 mengerngkan dana sumbangan RM2.1 Peribadi: Rezekikan, Maria Darul Salamah, Fauziah (FNU2014), dan Timbalan Pengarah Projek, Shafiq Hisham, berkata pusat itu dijanjikan mampu memajukan ekonomi setempat kerana ia membuka peluang pekerjaan kepada penduduk tempatan.

Katanya, kapal dari Vietnam yang membawa pelombongan asing sering singgah di Kampung itu sebelum meneruskan perjalanan ke Siam Reap, Kemboja, yang terkenal dengan Angkor Wat.

Lokasi ini berpotensi besar untuk berkembang dan mampu membantu menaik taraf kehidupan masyarakat Muslim di Kemboja.

"Selain menyediakan prasarana ekonomi, program ini membantu menaik taraf jalan raya dan memperbaiki kerosakan di kawasan ini," katanya.

Dalam pada itu, Shafiq berkata, seramai 80 mahasiswa FSKU Alam Bina UTM dan empat penyayang belajar membangunkan sebuah Pusat Infomasi Kampung dan Galeri Seni Bina di Kampung Khlong Sbek di Wilayah Kandal, Kemboja serta diilhamkan masyarakat setempat untuk mempromosikan kampung mereka dan lain-lain.

Pegawai Kampus Lestari UTM, Prof Madya Ir Dr Mohd Fadhil Md Din berkata, alat berkenaan bertujuan untuk memantau tahap kualiti udara sebenar UTM memandangkan stesen terdekat iaitu Larkin Lama adalah 13 kilometer dari UTM.

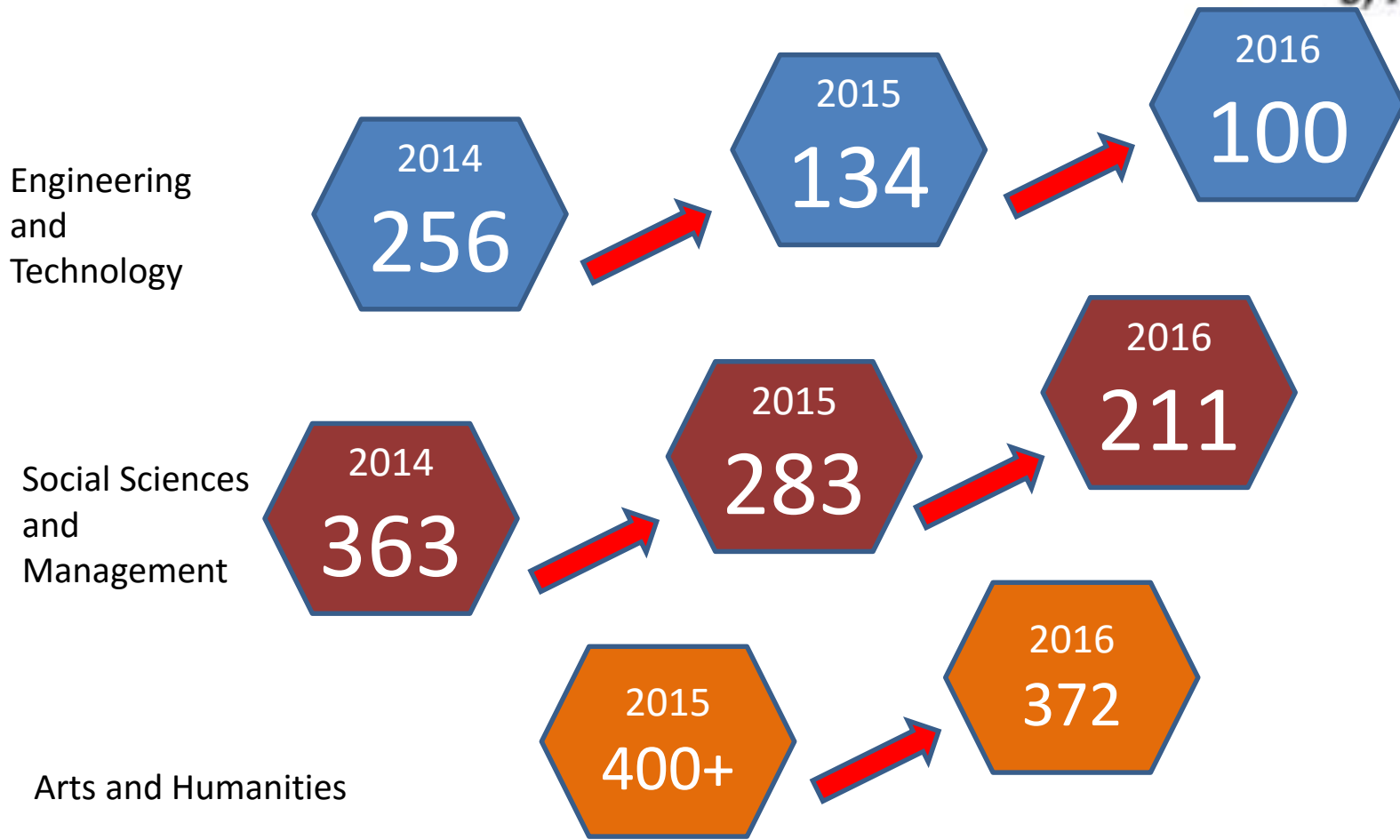

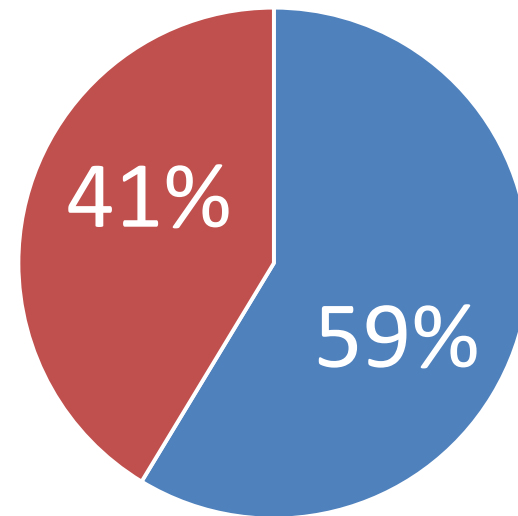
